With Autumn apon us we have been exploring the natural environment and using items found outside to create works of art....





Letter of the week....We are encouraging the children to bring items for show and tell that start with the letter of the week. This week the letter is **Dd**.

Phonics - Here at pre-school, we use the <u>Jolly Phonics</u> learning system. Generally, we introduce capital letters at the beginning of a child's name in the setting and only progress from there if we feel the child is ready.

If you feel you would like to extend your child's learning at home/ in the car, you can purchase a Jolly Phonic's CD to have at home which will aid your child's learning and hopefully they will recognise the familiar songs linked to the system they hear whilst at pre-school.
