
We further extended the story by showing the children a turtle, ant, snake, and chicken. They were asked what they all had in common.




One of our lovely mum's is a self-taught outstanding baker who has recently started her own business baking delicious treats for all occasions.

Andrea recently ran the Half Marathon in 2 hours and 7 minutes. How amazing she is doing!




TBPS Spring Sponsored Walk Sunday 26th March in Epping Forest

You and your family are warmly invited to join the Theydon Bois Pre-School Spring Sponsored Walk in Epping Forest.

As well as raising vital funds for the Pre-School through sponsoring the children, the event will help youngsters learn about nature. They will get an activity sheet and win stickers for spotting surprises on the day.

What: The walk is 1.75 miles and takes 45 minutes to an hour. Families are invited to start anytime between 2pm and 3pm. It is on wide paths and is buggy friendly. All children must be accompanied by an adult. As well as the map below, marshals will be on the route.



Where: It is a 10-minute walk to the start from Theydon Bois. There are three nearby pay car parks – Genesis Slade (from where the walk begins), Long Running and Jacks Hill.
