# What We Have Been Up To.

It has been a busy few weeks at the preschool! The children have enjoyed a range of fun activities. Below are some photos of what the children have been up to.



Woolly mittens art activity to represent how we keep warm in cold weather.

Volcanoes were made by the children following on from a child's interest. We introduced new words like ash, lava, and eruption. The children were extremely interested in talking and learning facts about volcanoes.





In this picture the children are hard at work creating 3D volcanoes using a variety of materials. There was lots of discussion using lots of new language.

The children had great fun playing outside on the hopscotch that the staff had drawn on the playground. They were great at lining up, taking turns and sharing.

The children loved feeding the birds outside and watching them.

Nest making – Children used a selection of material including twigs, leaves, and feathers to build their own bird's nest.





Here the children are out and about on a bird watch!

The children identified birds such as Sparrows, Blackbirds, Seagulls and 1 Magpie. On a chart the children used lines to mark how many birds they saw.



# What We Have Been Up To.



The children made their own bird food. We looked at how the fat used was first a solid, then a liquid once heated and then returned to a solid mass when cooled again, allowing them to mix in the bird food. Lots of new language and scientific words were used.



Making hanging bird feeders for our garden area as part of our Winter birds' topic. The children used a knife and their hands to spread the lard and add the bird food mix to their square plate. We extended the activity by playing the song 'Feed the birds' from Mary Poppins and all the teachers sang along.





The children perfected their fine motor skills during this transferring activity.

The children have worked really hard in our movement sessions. This was an adult led session, where the children copied the adult's movements. At the end of the session the children used the scarves to independently move their bodies in time with the music.
