The children split into two groups to paint large Pudsey bears using various tools to create different textures.














Our toys were 'in Need' so we called upon our Pre School Doctors and Nurses to help!

We played the spider game which is always a firm favourite amongst the children. They had to catch the number bugs and then claps their hands to match the number on their bug.


Remembrance Day
