Dear Parent/carers,

It has been another busy term for us at Pre School and the children have had so much fun exploring winter and getting ready for Christmas. We wanted to share some of their magical moments with you here, please show your child the photos and ask them what is happening in them. This is a great way to strengthen your child's communication and language skills as well as practising memory recall.

The children had such fun painting some collected twigs. They magnificently transformed them into winter branches by using fine paint brushes and white paint. Lastly, they added some glitter to represent winter frost.







We have enjoyed looking at various books on Arctic animals and the children extended this by creating their own polar bears using white paint and a plastic fork to create a fur like texture on their polar bears.





Everyone loves making magic potions, so we decided to make our very own magic winter potions at Pre School. The children eagerly gathered around with their plastic cups to create their very own potions. They selected glitter, natural foliage and used pipettes to transfer coloured water into their cups.

Did you know that allowing your child to play with a pipette supports their fine motor skills!

The children were encouraged to squeeze the bulb part at the top of the pipette and then submerge it into the coloured water, once it was securely in they were then encouraged to slowly release their grip. This was a challenge for some of the children but practice makes perfect and we will continue using our pipettes in other activities. Once each child had a full pipette we encouraged them to transfer the water with a steady hand to their potion cups and that's how the magic happened!







The children took part in a discussion about winter clothing and were able to say that they need to wear a hat, gloves and scarf as well as a coat to keep warm in the winter. They also talked about the weather and that when it becomes really cold it can sometimes snow which is such fun as they can then play in it and build snowmen. 






Christmas is almost here and the children have been so excited telling us all about what they have been up to at home from putting up their trees to visiting Santa with their families.

The children created some fabulous reindeer tree decorations by imprinting their feet in a salt dough mixture they made. We have added the simple salt dough recipe below in case you want to try this fun activity at home with your children.

The above salt dough recipe can be followed and if you would like fast results just place your child's creation on a baking sheet, pop it into the oven on gas mark 6 for 2-3 hours. Once it has cooled down it is ready to paint and decorate. Salt dough can also be left out to dry overnight and when it is hard and dry your child can decorate it.

If you do give this fun activity a go at home we would love to see your child's masterpieces at Pre School.

Lastly, could we politely remind you that we do not have any storage space at Pre School for pushchairs, scooters or bikes. Please can we kindly ask you to take them back home with you or alternatively chain them to the railings outside the main exit doors.
