Reminders

Please can we remind you if your child is not coming into Pre School then please call us and let us know.

We encourage all parents/carers to bring their children into Pre School on the agreed sessions however, if you need to take your child out of Pre School for any reason such as a family holiday/sickness then we ask you to let us know.

Please label ALL your child's belongings (including their lunchbox), uniform and coat as this makes life easier for everyone.

Important information and language we use

Starting points – These were discussed with your child's key person during induction and together we decide on what your child's starting point are on entry in their learning and development.

Two Year Progress Check – This is NOT the Health Visitor (HV) check that your child should have had before they start their Pre School journey with us. This is a check that is carried out at your child's nursery if they started one before the age of three. We ask you if your child has had one in their other setting to supply us with a copy of it and if they attend more than one setting and have not yet had the check then we must decide what setting is most suitable to carry out the check.

Finally, we would like to thank you all for your support so far and look forward to welcoming you to the Autumn term.
