



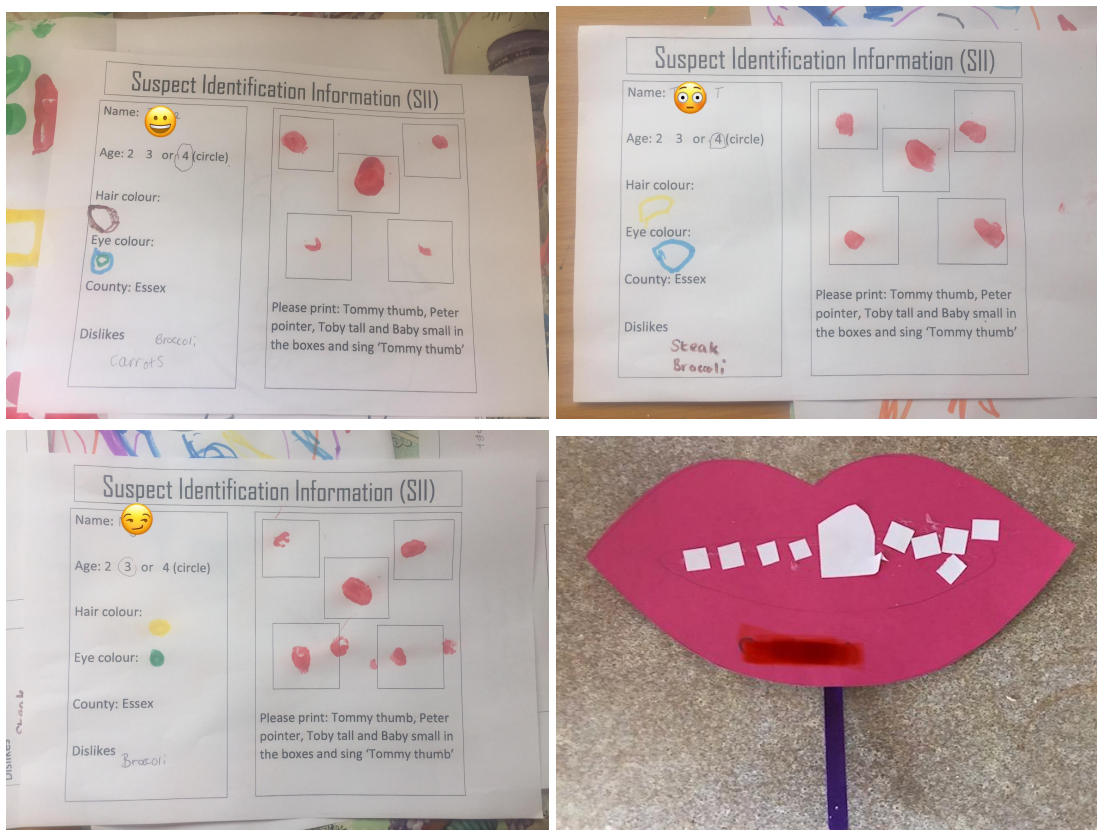

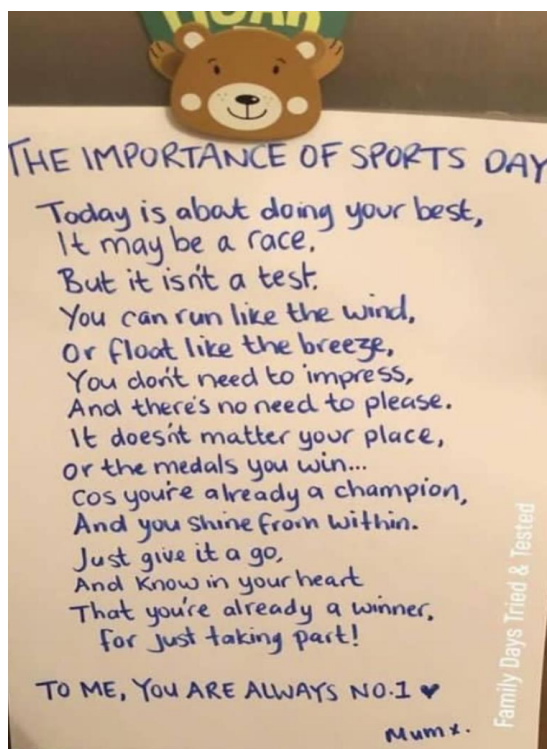
Read on for what the children will be doing this week....
